Tour Itinerary

APRIL 19, 2022 - ARRIVAL DAY

Check-in to Hotel Commonwealth in Boston. Meet SET staff to pick up on-site travel documents. This evening, gather for a Welcome Reception & Dinner to meet fellow travelers and learn more about what to expect on the tour from tour host Michael Raycraft, PhD.

APRIL 20, 2022

Following breakfast, depart for a private tour of historic Fenway Park. In the early afternoon, travel to Harvard Yard to tour the area and learn about Harvard's impact on sports. The day will conclude back at Fenway Park to watch the Boston Red Sox take on the Toronto Blue Jays.

APRIL 21, 2022

After breakfast, enjoy a scenic motor coach ride to Cooperstown, and check-in to The Otesaga Resort. The evening will be at your leisure to enjoy Cooperstown.

APRIL 22, 2022

Following breakfast, meet with the National Baseball Hall of Fame staff for a private Artifact Spotlight - a hands-on baseball experience - and a tour of the National Baseball Hall of Fame. Afternoon will be at leisure and the day will wrap up with a group dinner.

APRIL 23, 2022

Enjoy breakfast before setting out for New York City for the final leg of the tour. Check-in to The Refinery Hotel and then meet to take the subway to Yankee Stadium. A Pre-Game tour of Yankee Stadium will be followed by watching the New York Yankees take on the Cleveland Guardians.

APRIL 24, 2022 - DEPARTURE DAY

After breakfast, check out of The Refinery Hotel, and have a safe trip home

Reservations & Payments Reservations may be made online, by phone or by mail. Deposits and/or final payment may be made by Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover or Check. The final balance of your payment will be due 60 days prior to the trip. The credit card used to make the reservation will be automatically charged 60 days out unless notified otherwise. If final payment is not received by Sports & Entertainment Travel, LLC by the final payment due date, Sports & Entertainment Travel, LLC may, at any time and with or without notice, cancel your reservation in its sole discretion with no right of refund. Travel packages booked within 60 days of the package start date will require full payment upon booking and are nonrefundable.

Cancellations, Refunds and Changes Cancellations made more than 60 days prior to travel will result in a loss of the tour deposit.
