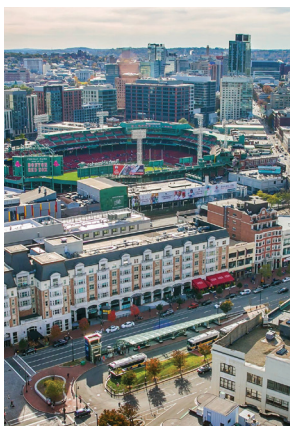

Your Itinerary

- DAY ONE** Arrival Day - Check into Hotel Commonwealth, meet SET staff, & pick up on-site travel documents. In the early evening, enjoy a Welcome Reception, featuring dinner & “Baseball 101” discussion with Dr. Michael Raycraft.
- DAY TWO** Following breakfast, the group will walk to Fenway Park for a private tour of one of baseball’s most historic ballparks. After the tour, the group will travel to Harvard University for a tour of Harvard’s Athletic facilities, Harvard Yard, and partake in discussion to learn about Harvard’s impact on sports. Guests will have an afternoon of leisure, the day will conclude back at Fenway Park to watch the Red Sox take on the Tampa Bay Rays.
- DAY THREE** After breakfast, we will take a scenic bus ride to Historic Cooperstown, along with a brief stop in Stockbridge for lunch at the Red Lion Inn along the way. After checking into the Otesaga Resort, kick back and relax before a group dinner along with a brief lecture on Cooperstown’s significant to baseball and the Hall of Fame.
- DAY FOUR** National Baseball Hall of Fame Day! Following breakfast, the group will be welcomed by Hall of Fame staff and taken for a private Artifact Spotlight for an up close experience of historic baseball items. Afterwards, the group will tour the Hall of Fame. The afternoon and evening will be at leisure to explore all Cooperstown has to offer.
- DAY FIVE** Following breakfast, the group will depart Cooperstown for New York City and check into the Refinery Hotel. The day will feature a tour of Yankee Stadium to experience the home of baseball’s most storied franchise, followed by followed by watching the Yankees face off against the Chicago White Sox.
- DAY SIX** Departure Day - Following breakfast, check out of the Refinery Hotel & have a safe trip home!
