Discovery

Antwerp. This fascinating Belgian city has long been an important seaport and center of trade. On a guided walk in the old town, view its wealth of medieval architecture. See the Gothic Cathedral of Our Lady that soars over the skyline, the colorful 16th-century town hall, and the Grote Markt square lined with a striking row of narrow guild halls.

Kampen. During a guided walk, see the stately buildings, grand old town gates and peaceful squares of this richly historic city on the banks of the IJssel, which was once a member of the powerful medieval Hanseatic network of trading partners.

Rijksmuseum: Vermeer Exhibition.

View fabulous art and artifacts covering 800 years of Dutch history, including a one-ofa-kind exhibition of Johannes Vermeer's masterpieces. One of history's finest artists, Vermeer is famed for his command of color, composition and light. Take in an exceptional display of paintings representing most of his life's work which are on loan from around the world and unlikely to be shown together ever again due to the age of the pieces.

Vermeer's "Girl With a Pearl Earring" is housed at the Mauritshuis and will not be a part of this special Rijksmuseum exhibit. If you would like to see it, select the "The Hague and the Mauritshuis" PYJ excursion.

Keukenhof Gardens. Explore this 80-acre paradise of brightly colored tulips, hyacinths, daffodils and other gorgeous flowers.

Canals of Amsterdam. Enjoy a unique perspective of the city on a guided boat ride that takes you past enchanting, 17th-century canal houses and other architectural gems.
