Day 1 | **In Transit**

Depart your gateway city for Athens, Greece. 🌐

Day 2 | **Athens, Greece**

Arrive and transfer ➡ to the NJV Athens Plaza Hotel.

Free Time: Spend the remainder of the day exploring Athens on your own.

This evening, meet and get to know your fellow travelers at a Welcome Dinner.

Day 3 | **Athens**

Discovery: Athens City Tour. Get acquainted with legendary Athens, the birthplace of democracy and Western philosophy, theater and architecture. See the Academy of Athens, University of Athens, the National Library and other landmarks on a panoramic tour. Then head up to the resplendent Acropolis, adorned with monuments built by ancient Greece’s finest architects, sculptors and artists in the fifth century B.C. Take in the Parthenon’s classical lines and sweeping city views. At the Acropolis Museum, view exquisite artifacts and study the ruins of an ancient neighborhood through the glass floor. *(Active)*

Free Time: The rest of the day is yours to plan.

Day 4 | **Mycenae | Gytheio**

After breakfast, check out of the hotel. Depart Athens and journey toward Gytheio, a seaside city on the ruggedly majestic Mani Peninsula.

Discovery: Mycenae and Greek Wines. On your route, take a fascinating, guided tour of the hilltop

ruins of Mycenae, one of the oldest archaeological sites on the Peloponnese and a UNESCO World Heritage site. The Mycenaean civilization developed and flourished here during the Bronze Age from roughly 1600–1200 B.C., and their culture would later profoundly inspire the Greeks of the Classical period. Imagine this fortified citadel in all its glory as you walk under the imposing Lion’s Gate! Afterward, travel to a winery for an excellent introduction to Greek winemaking that includes a tasting and lunch. *(Active)*

Check in to the Las Hotel & Spa in Gytheio. As a special welcome to Gytheio, enjoy a cocktail and an appetizing buffet dinner with your group this evening.

The Peloponnese

Surrounded by the Aegean and Ionian seas, the Peloponnese is a mythic land, home to Greece's most magnificent and celebrated cities of antiquity. From these shores, King Agamemnon of Mycenae rallied troops to sail for Troy to rescue Helen, daughter of Zeus and the Spartan queen Leda. Its alluring, mountainous landscape, connected to the mainland by the Isthmus of Corinth, stretches south across four smaller peninsulas, including the marvelous Mani. In this quieter, timeless region, visitors are rewarded with dramatic coastal vistas, peaceful beaches beside the bright blue sea, the freshest culinary delights and a true appreciation for what makes traditional Greek life so captivating.

Day 5 | **Gytheio | Areopoli | Limeni | Thalames**

Discovery: *The Mani Peninsula.* Begin your day with a short walk in Gytheio to learn more about its history. Then embark on a panoramic drive along winding, coastal roads to soak up the wild, remote splendor of the Mani. Your first stop is Areopoli, known for the role it played in the Greek Revolution, when local Maniots defiantly declared war against the Ottoman Empire in 1821. On a stroll in the lovely old town, delight in its warm ambience and traditional stone houses. Later, travel to Limeni, one of the Mani's prettiest coastal villages, for fabulous views of the crystal-clear turquoise bay, and pause for lunch on your route. Cap off your travels with a tour of a working olive mill in Thalames featuring a rare stone mill.

Enrichment: *Greek History.*

Free Time: Find a cozy spot in Gytheio for dinner.

Day 6 | **Mystras | Sparta**

Enrichment: *Classical Greece.*

Discovery: *Mystras, Sparta and the Greek Olive.* Set off this morning to tour the grand ruins of Mystras, a medieval Byzantine city on a mountainside over the Laconian plain. Learn about its significance in Byzantine culture from your guide and admire the monasteries, chapels and churches adorned with frescoes. Next, travel to Sparta for a guided walk through the ruins of one of Greece's greatest city-states. Finally, visit Sparta's informative Museum of the Olive and Greek Olive Oil, which details why the olive is so prized by the Greeks. During your travels today, take a break for a delicious lunch. *(Active)*

Free Time: Create your own agenda in Gytheio.

Day 7 | Monemvasia

Discovery: Monemvasia. As you gaze from the mainland at the rocky island before you, you wouldn't suspect that a fortified medieval town lies on it. To avoid enemy attacks, Monemvasia was built on the opposite side, facing the sea, with only one entrance via a narrow causeway. Enter this picturesque, hidden gem today through the castle gate, and meander on

the labyrinth of cobblestone streets lined by honey-colored stone mansions, churches and mosques that reflect its Byzantine, Venetian and Ottoman past. See Christos Elkomenos, the Lower Town's most prominent church, and Agia Sofia, a Byzantine church atop a cliff.

Free Time: Relax over lunch in Monemvasia. In Gytheio tonight, watch the sun set over the Laconian Gulf from a wonderful vantage point, then dine with your group in town.

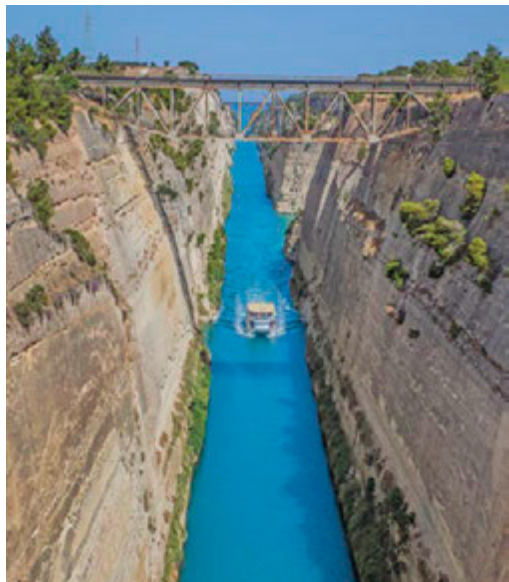
Day 8 | Gytheio

Enrichment: Contemporary Greece.

Free Time: Savor your gorgeous surroundings today! Maybe you'll set up a chair in the sand and unwind on nearby beaches like Mavrovouni or Ageranos, and follow up with a leisurely lunch at a taverna by the water.

Day 9 | Corinth | Athens

This morning, check out of the hotel and depart for Athens with a stop in Corinth on your return.

Discovery: Corinth Canal. This deep channel, built in 1893, separates the Peloponnese from the mainland. Get an up-close glimpse during a boat ride and break for lunch after your cruise.

Continue to Athens and check in to the NJV Athens Plaza Hotel.

Free Time: Take advantage of your final afternoon and evening in Athens for more sightseeing or shopping.

Day 10 | In Transit

Transfer ➡ to the airport for the return flight ➡ to your gateway city.

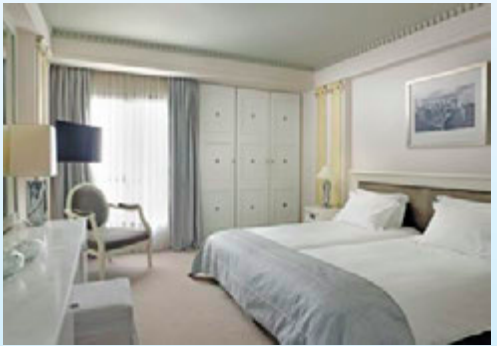

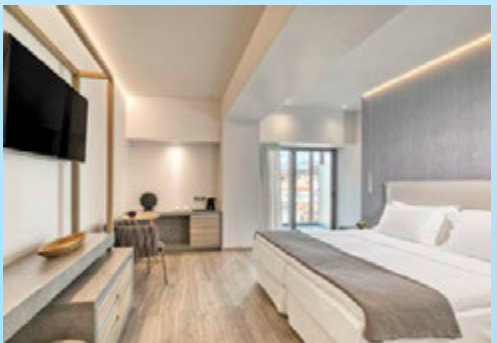
