Day 1 | In Transit

Depart your gateway city for Tel Aviv, Israel.

Day 2 | Tel Aviv, Israel

Arrive and transfer **3** to your hotel. Join us this evening for a convivial Welcome Reception.

Day 3 | Tel Aviv

Enrichment: Contemporary Israel.

Ancient Jaffa. Your adventure begins along the 4,000-year-old cobblestones of Jaffa. Revel in the many treasures of this old-world gem.

Neve Tzedek & ANU Museum. Enjoy a walking tour of the artsy Neve Tzedek district. Tel Aviv's first neighborhood boasts a variety of boutiques, classic bistros and art galleries. Continue to the ANU – The Museum of the Jewish People to learn about the ongoing story of the Jewish people and see rare artifacts.

Day 4 | Tel Aviv | Jerusalem

The White City. This morning, witness the stunning Bauhaus architecture of "The White City," a UNESCO World Heritage designation.

Free Time: Soak up the buzzing atmosphere

of the Machane Yehuda market. Browse stalls filled with textiles, spices and tasty local foods.

Yad Vashem: A Poignant Monument. Join a guide for a tour of the moving and powerful Holocaust Memorial Museum.

Enrichment: A Survivor Speaks.

Check in to your hotel and enjoy a group dinner.

Day 5 | Jerusalem

The City of David. Discover Jerusalem's Old City, brimming with landmarks that are sacred to three of the world's great faiths. Visit the Mount of Olives and Temple Mount, home to the golden Dome of the Rock. See interesting archaeological relics at the Davidson Center and pause at the Western Wall. After a falafel lunch, visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre and walk along the Via Dolorosa, believed to be the path Jesus walked to his crucifixion.

Enrichment: Is it Finally Time for a Peace Deal?

Day 6 | Masada | Jerusalem

Judean Desert Drama. Venture to Masada, King Herod's 2,000-year-old clifftop fortress.

During an insightful walking tour, learn about the significant events and great heroism that took place here.

Day 7 | Caesarea | Mount Carmel | Akko | Tiberias

Mediterranean Coast, Mount Carmel & Akko. Start the day with a walking tour of Caesarea, built by Herod the Great. Gaze at the massive Roman theater and the splendid hippodrome that once held 20,000 spectators. After an authentic Druze lunch, visit the coastal city of Haifa to enjoy views of the Baha'i Shrine and its lovely gardens. Next, visit the port city of Akko (Acre), one of the world's oldest continuously inhabited settlements. See the Crusader fort and follow in the footsteps of Romans, Egyptians, Persians and others. Check in to your hotel in Tiberias.

AHI Connects | Celebrate Shabbat. Share a Shabbat dinner with a family in their home. Learn about this weekly observance and try challah, a traditional bread.

Day 8 | Tabgha | Qatsrin | Tiberias

Upper Galilee & Capernaum. Embark on a scenic cruise on the Sea of Galilee (weather permitting). Visit the quiet fishing village of

Tabgha and the Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus is believed to have delivered the Sermon on the Mount. Continue to Capernaum, said to have been built on the home of Saint Peter.

Israeli Wine. Explore local vintages during tastings at a Golan Heights winery.

Day 9 | Jerash, Jordan | Amman

Jerash. Enjoy a tour of Jerash, one of the world's best-preserved Greco-Roman sites. Admire the city's monumental arches, Roman baths, hilltop temples and spacious plazas. Arrive in Amman and check in to your hotel.

Day 10 | Madaba | Mount Nebo | Wadi Musa (Petra)


Madaba & Mount Nebo. Find incredible Byzantine mosaics in Madaba, including a famous mosaic floor map inside the Greek Orthodox St. George's Church. Then ascend Mount Nebo. According to the Hebrew Bible, it was here that Moses glimpsed the Promised Land. Sweeping views of the Dead Sea, Jordan Valley and Jericho await at the summit. Check in to your hotel in Wadi Musa.

Day 11 | Wadi Musa (Petra)

Amazing Petra. Rise early to encounter the

legendary biblical site of Petra. Walk through the narrow Siq, a canyon carved into red and apricot rock. The Siq leads to the pink-hued Treasury, the most famous of Petra's temples. Continue on a walking tour to admire the city's temples, royal tombs, shrines and other outstanding archeological wonders.

Day 12 | Sweimeh | Dead Sea

Journey to your hotel by the Dead Sea.

Sea of Salt. The Dead Sea is the deepest hypersaline lake in the world. This afternoon, you have plenty of time to relax on the beach or swim in the mineral-rich waters.

Gather for a Farewell Reception and Dinner.

Day 13 | In Transit

Transfer to the Amman airport for the return flight to your gateway city.


