Day 1 | In-transit

Depart for Lisbon, Portugal. 🌐

Day 2 | Lisbon, Portugal

Arrive in Lisbon, transfer 🚗 and check in to the Dom Pedro Lisboa hotel.

This evening, meet your fellow travelers at a Welcome Reception, with canapés.

Day 3 | Lisbon

Lisbon City Tour. Uncover Lisbon's highlights on a guided, half-day panoramic tour. See the majestic 16th-century Tower of Belém and the nautical Monument to the Discoveries. Visit the Jerónimos Monastery, an excellent example of Manueline architecture and tribute to Portugal's Golden Age. Follow the Tagus River and pause at the Praça do Comércio square to admire the stunning waterfront views and snap a photo.

Free Time: Enjoy the rest of the day at leisure.

Day 4 | Terceira Island, Azores | Angra do Heroísmo

After breakfast, fly to Terceira. Arrive, transfer and check in to the Azoris Angra Garden.

Enrichment: History of the Azores.

Angra do Heroísmo. On a guided walk of this city founded in 1478, stroll to the central square and visit the well-preserved City Hall. Admire its Portuguese colonial architecture with baroque elements and delve into the city's rich history. Savor flavorful local cuisine at lunch together.

🌐 **AHI Connects | Azorean Dinner.** Travel to an authentic Azorean farmstead to peruse the market, discover the island's culinary heritage and relish dinner in the atmospheric farmhouse.

Day 5 | Terceira | São Sebastião

Terceira. Get to know the island on a scenic panoramic island tour, making stops to witness breathtaking views and the 15th-century church in São Sebastião, and have lunch. Continue to Algar do Carvão and make a thrilling descent into the surreal lava tube with moss-covered walls and rare translucent stalactites. *(Active)*

Conclude the day in Biscoitos. Take a dip in a natural lava rock pool or relax at a local café.

Day 6 | Faial Island | Horta

After breakfast, board a short flight to Faial.

Faial Tour. Head to the Capelinhos Volcano to uncover the history of the 1957 eruption that vastly altered the island's landscape. Pause at a viewpoint on the rim of the majestic Caldeira do Cabeço Gordo to marvel at the deep green volcanic bowl. Drive to Horta past sweeping views of Horta Bay and Pico Mountain. Enjoy lunch and check in to the Azoris Faial Garden.

Free Time: The rest of the day is at your leisure.

Day 7 | Pico Island | Faial

Vineyards of Pico. Revel in an early morning ferry ride over to Pico. Visit the Criação Velha vineyards to be awed by grapevines growing in black basalt stone walls, a striking contrast to the deep-blue ocean, and learn about the island's 500-year-old viticulture techniques and mineral-rich Verdelho wine. Then, relish lunch with Pico wines at a nearby winery.

Lajes & Whaling History. Tour the Whaler's Museum in Lajes, a major whaling hub from the 18th century until 1984. Understand the Azores complex whaling history via exhibits of whaling boats, harpoons, historical documents and photos, illustrating the whalers' daily lives. Take the ferry back to Faial and your hotel.

Day 8 | Faial | São Miguel Island | Ponta Delgada

Enrichment: Contemporary Azores.

After the lecture, fly to Ponta Delgada on São Miguel Island. Arrive, have lunch and set out on your walking tour of this capital city.

Ponta Delgada & Carlos Machado Museum.

On a guided stroll, appreciate the grand black basalt city gates with whitewashed accents, charming squares with colorful Portuguese pavement designs and the 17th-century City

Hall. Visit the Carlos Machado Museum to see exhibits showcasing natural history, devotional and other art, and proud Azorean heritage. Check in to the Octant Ponta Delgada hotel.

Day 9 | São Miguel | Furnas

Furnas Crater. Head to the village of Furnas to stand in awe at the Lagoa das Furnas volcanic crater lake, surrounded by misty green hills and dotted with steaming fumaroles, bubbling mud pools and sulfur vents. Watch as the traditional Cozido das Furnas stew is buried in the ground to be cooked by volcanic heat. Later, savor the delicious stew for lunch at a nearby restaurant.

Terra Nostra Park. Explore the lush botanical haven of extraordinary plant species, Romantic architecture and orange thermal waters.

Gorreana Tea Factory. Visit Europe's oldest tea plantation still in operation to meander in the tea fields and tour the production factory.

Day 10 | São Miguel | Ribeira Grande

Whale Watching. Embark on a thrilling boat expedition to look for sightings of majestic,

Crater Lake & Iconic Waterfall. Set out for the center of the island to visit the magnificent Lagoa do Fogo crater lake within a volcanic massif. Continue to the Caldeira Velha nature preserve to be mesmerized by the warm iron waterfall enveloped by mist and lush ferns.

Ribeira Grande. Stroll along the azulejo-tiled streets of this town steeped in Portuguese character. Admire the baroque Town Hall and the graceful, arched Ribeira Grande Bridge.

Day 11 | São Miguel | Sete Cidades

Jeep Excursion. Venture to a remote volcanic crater region, stopping at the serene Canário Lake for stunning panoramic views of one of the Azores' most iconic natural wonders, the blue-green twin lakes of Sete Cidades, nestled in a vast volcanic crater amid lush forests.

Farewell Festivities. Delight in this evening's reception, dinner and folklore performance.

Day 12 | In Transit

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and transfer to the Ponta Delgada Airport for your return flights home.
