Day 1 | **Miami, Florida | Lima, Peru**

Depart Miami for Lima, Peru. Upon arrival, transfer to the Pullman Lima Miraflores.

Day 2 | **Lima**

**Highlights of Lima.** View the Larco Museum's excellent collection of pottery and artifacts that spans more than 5,000 years of pre-Columbian Peruvian history. Continue to Plaza Mayor lined with stately, colonial-era buildings in Lima's historic center. After a guided stroll, stop for lunch at a nearby restaurant. Later, see the splendid interior of the Cathedral of Lima, and visit the beautiful Monastery of Santo Domingo with relics of important Peruvian saints and a cloister ornamented with Spanish azulejo tiles. Next, tour Casa Aliaga, a delightful gem built in 1535 and still occupied by descendants of the Aliaga family. Admire its grand rooms richly adorned in wood and the tranquil courtyard.

 **AHI Connects | Meet the People.** Tonight, enjoy a Welcome Reception and Dinner at Casa Garcia Alvarado, a National Historical Building. Tour this elegant home and savor a traditional meal with one of the owners.

Day 3 | **Lima | Cusco | Sacred Valley**

Check out of the hotel after breakfast and transfer to the airport for your flight to Cusco. Upon arrival, take a panoramic drive to the stunning Urubamba Valley, the Sacred Valley of the Incas, amid towering mountain slopes. Check in to the Casa Andina Premium Valle Sagrado and dine on Andean cuisine tonight.

Day 4 | **Sacred Valley**

**Sacred Valley.** Take in the Moray Terraces created by the Inca in the 15th century as an experimental farm, and visit the striking Maras Salt Mines, where salt has been extracted from terraced pools for centuries. Enjoy lunch later at a family estate that boasts gorgeous views and artwork. Then, travel to a mountain village, and learn about ancient weaving methods and life in this challenging environment.

Day 5 | **Sacred Valley | Machu Picchu**

**Ollantaytambo.** Explore this Inca hillside fortress renowned for its huge terraces.

Next, travel by train through the scenic Sacred Valley to the town of Aguas Calientes.

high in the Andes, the Lost City of the Incas is regarded as the most important archaeological site in the Americas. Appreciate the Incas' exceptional architectural skills as you meander through the temples, palaces and plazas of this mountaintop complex with your guide.

Check in to the Inkaterre Machu Picchu Pueblo, where you'll dine this evening.

#### Day 6 | Machu Picchu | Cusco

Check out of the hotel this morning for your return train trip through the area's lovely mountain scenery. Then, travel by motor coach to the Palacio del Inka in Cusco.

**Free Time:** Make your own plans in Cusco.

#### Day 7 | Cusco

**Cusco, Ancient Inca Capital.** Set 11,152 feet above sea level, Cusco was the religious and administrative center of the Inca Empire. Enjoy guided visits to the Cathedral on the Plaza de Armas, noted for its colonial art, and the Santo Domingo Church, built on the foundations of the Incas' Koricancha Temple. Afterward, take a break for a delicious lunch nearby.

**Sacsayhuaman.** Marvel at the immense

stones (one weighs 125 tons!) of this imposing Inca fortress constructed without any mortar.

#### Day 8 | Cusco | Lima | Iquitos | Nauta | Embark ship

This morning, transfer to Cusco's airport for your flight to Iquitos via Lima. Make your way through Iquitos, the gateway to the Amazon and accessible only by plane or boat, to Nauta on the Marañon River. On your route, see the vibrant terra firma (non-flooded forest). Embark the Delfin III at a private port in Nauta. As your cruise begins, soak up sweeping views from the observation deck while your naturalist guide reviews upcoming activities and the wildlife and plants that you are likely to see.

#### Day 9 | Cruising the Amazon Basin

Set out aboard skiff boats, anticipating the day's astounding and unexpected wildlife encounters. Pacaya Samiria National Reserve, where the ship cruises, is one of Peru's largest wildlife preserves with more than five million acres of rich biodiversity. Marvel at gray and pink dolphins and watch for toucans and macaws hiding in the rain forest.

After breakfast, disembark the ship in Nauta and transfer by coach to the Iquitos airport.

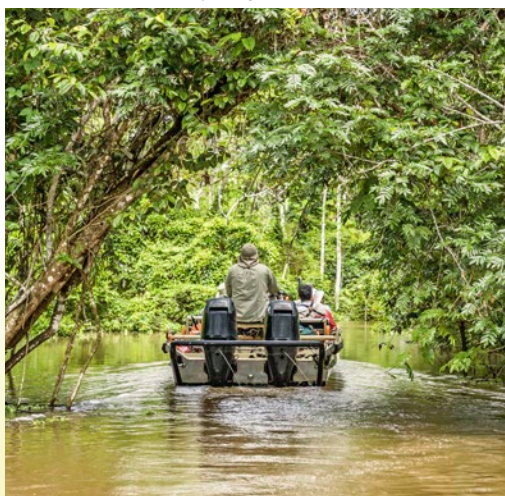
## Active Travel

### Excursions on this program require:

- walking distances of up to 3–5 miles
- walking on cobblestones, unpaved paths and/or uneven and slippery surfaces
- getting on and off motor coaches, boats and/or trains
- climbing in and out of excursion boats
- walking up (sometimes steep) hills in ports where docks are not available and at sites in the Sacred Valley
- tolerating various climatic conditions, including high altitude and humidity
